Virtual Child Protection Response Team Training

Protecting Children from Abuse by Strengthening School Response – Response Team Training Level I

Dates: 23-26 March 2021

Times: 11am-4pm ET (30min lunch break)

Course will be delivered through Zoom

Audience: School Response Teams (minimum 2 ppl / max 10 ppl)

Cost: US\$500 per school

Language: Will be offered in ENGLISH and SPANISH

***Teams can divide into ENG or SPAN trainings, as they will happen simultaneously**

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OBJECTIVES:

- Understand child protection accreditation standards and foundational beliefs
- Determine needed policies and stages of implementation
- Audit or create CP policies and procedures
- Identify supporting resources, including ITFCP Allegation Protocol and materials for staff training
- Prioritize creation of supplemental policies
- Understand victim and offender behavior
- Identify and accomplish five fast tasks that make your school safer
- Practice question formation and understand trauma informed approach as first responder to disclosure

Individual team planning using provided resources will be emphasized. Online tools, such as polling, and breakout rooms will enable participant interaction and exchange by role and country location. Support and resources for whole staff training will be provided through a training the trainer approach.

The training is focused on strengthening capacity of child protection response teams within schools only, not all staff training. For schools with no established response team, participants that would benefit from attending include child protection designates and deputies, senior leaders and designated board member, counselors, human resource professionals, athletic and activity directors, nurse/medical staff, and staff with special child protection responsibilities including IT, social emotional learning (SEL), trips/service learning, and curriculum areas of vulnerability including early years, special needs, athletics, music and performing arts.

It is recommended that schools send a minimum of two staff members in support of this learning.
